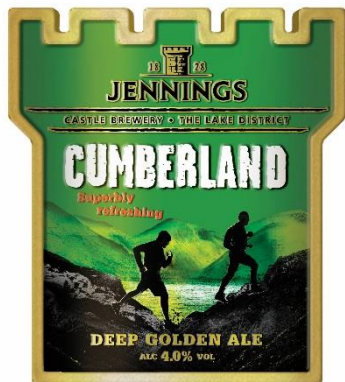

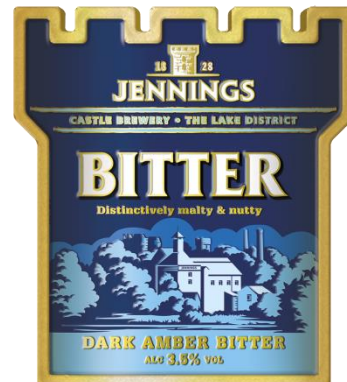
Style: Bitter

Brewed with a variety of dark roasted malts, English pale ale malt and specially formulated brewing sugar to give a biscuity aroma with a full bodied, robust nutty flavour. A zingy pale straw coloured ale. Hopped in the copper with delicious English Goldings and late hopped with a fist full of Styrian Goldings to give this beer a wonderful citrus and floral aroma. The use of classic English pale ale malt provides a balanced platform for the explosion of aromatic flavours delivered from each mouthful.
